Essential Work Activities

- Study blueprints, schematics, manuals, or other specifications to determine installation procedures.
- Inspect components of industrial/electrical equipment for accurate assembly and installation.
- Inspect equipment for defects, such as loose connections or frayed wires, and diagnose electrical problems.
- Test mechanical and electrical systems to ensure proper functioning.
- Repair or adjust equipment, machines, or defective components, and replace worn parts, such as gaskets or seals in watertight electrical equipment, to ensure optimal performance.
- Perform scheduled preventive maintenance tasks, such as checking and cleaning equipment.
- Coordinate efforts with coworkers involved in installing or maintaining equipment.
- Any miscellaneous duties that may be assigned from time to time.
