Essential Duties

- Weld components in flat, vertical, or overhead positions.
- Follow all safety guidelines according to company and OSHA standards.
- Recognize, set up, and operate hand and power tools common to the welding trade, such as shielded metal arc and gas metal arc welding equipment.
- Analyze engineering drawings, blueprints, specifications, sketches, work orders, and material safety data sheets to plan layout, assembly, and welding operations.
- Weld mostly steel structures, some TIG welding.
- Drill holes in parts, equipment, or materials.
- Ensure accuracy of inventory by maintaining strict control of materials.
- Measure dimensions of completed products or workpieces to verify conformance to specifications.
- Conduct tests and inspections of products, services, or processes to evaluate quality or performance.
- Determine the kind of tools and equipment needed to do a job.
- Willing and able to rotate through various tasks required in a particular production process.
- Determine work assignments, procedures, and communicate production level to management daily.
- Perform quality checks on parts/products.
- Participate in miscellaneous duties assigned from time to time.

Physical Demands
